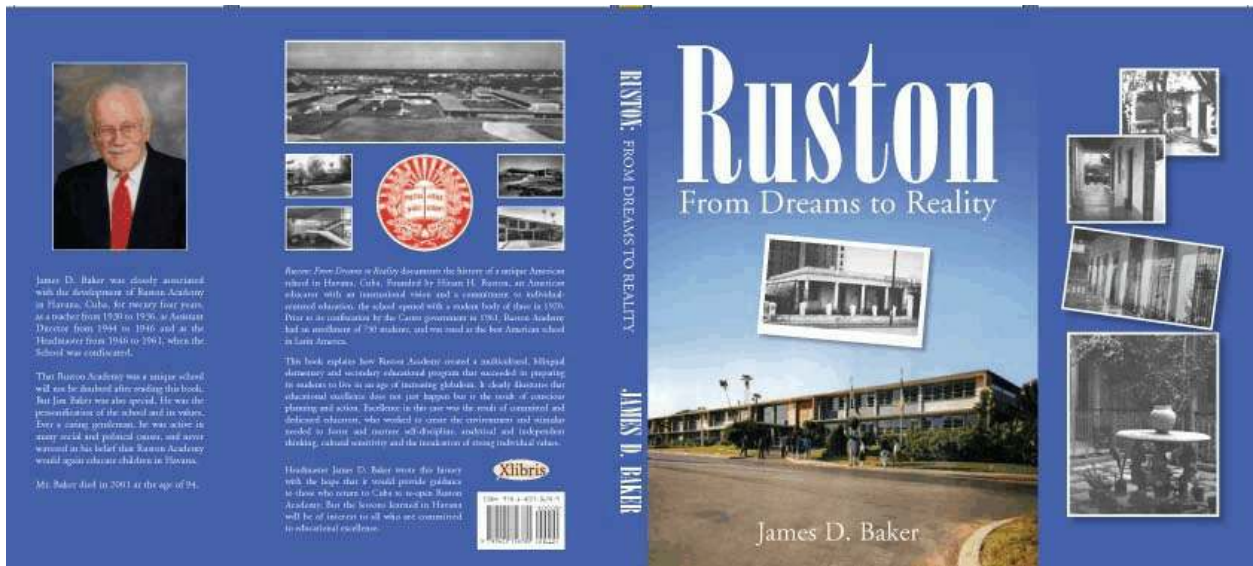


DEAR RUSTONIANS AND FRIENDS OF RUSTON,

Books ordered and paid for by this date will be exempted from shipping and handling charges. Orders placed after March 18th will be priced at \$25 and \$35 which will include a \$3 charge for shipping and handling. Books ordered within the next ten days will be assured expedited printing attention. Books which are ordered after March 18th will probably not be available until a month or more after the reunion.

Profits from the sale of the book will go to the Ruston-Baker Educational Institution (RBEI) and used to help fund the distribution of free copies of the book to selected libraries, institutions and individuals which we deem to be important potential contributors or supporters.
